## **PENSION REFORM:**

HOW CANADA CAN LEAD THE WORLD

There is a broad consensus that Canada has done a good job keeping the public part of its pension system sustainable. There is no such consensus about our supplemental pension arrangements (i.e., employment pension plans and RRSPs). Concerns have been raised about the design of these arrangements, how they are managed, and how they are regulated. There are also concerns about the adequacy of coverage and retirement savings rates. Are these concerns legitimate? If they are, how can they best be addressed? Keith Ambachtsheer will lead off this year's Benefactors Lecture. He will be followed by moderated discussions by Malcolm Hamilton and Bill Robson, with Nick Le Pan as moderator.
